Judge Pence's Most Noteworthy Rulings

1964: <u>Island Airlines, Inc. v. Civil Aeronautics Board.</u>

Determined the boundaries of the State of Hawaii.

1965-73: State of Utah v. American Pipe, et al.

Presided over and processed all (over 400) of the antitrust actions filed in the Ninth Circuit and in the District of Utah in the "West of the Rockies" steel and concrete pipe antitrust cases.

1973-78: <u>Kaiser Aetna v. United States.</u>

Decided upon limitation of the public use of privately constructed waterways.

1974-77: Robinson v. Ariyoshi.

Water rights in Hawaii.

1976-83: Pfizer, Inc. v. International Rectifier Corp.

Presided over this patent infringement action. Trial of patent validity took 6 months (1978-79), and trial of damages took 6 weeks (1983). Awarded Pfizer \$55 million in damages.
